Enriching the lives of those who have dyslexia is at the heart of our charity.

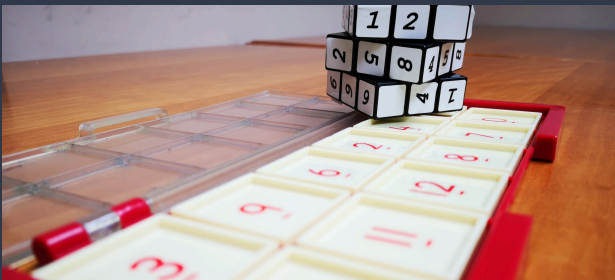
Our team of dedicated, caring specialists provide professional advice, screening, diagnostics and tuition.

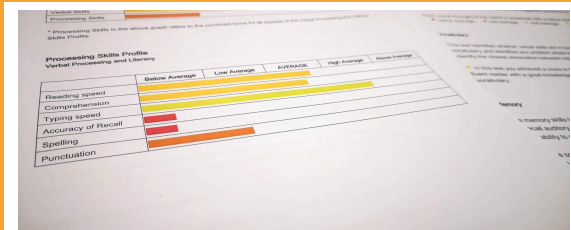

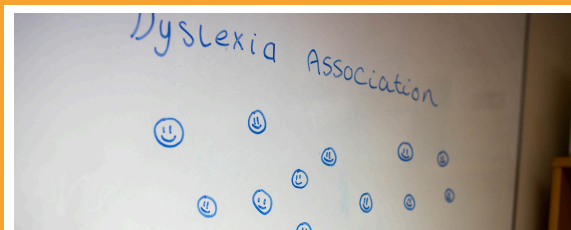
Diagnostic & Screening Services
